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☀️ Surah Overview: Surah Al-Mulk (The Kingdom) ☀️

Surah Al-Mulk is the first surah in **Juz 29** of the Qur'an. It was revealed in **Makkah** and it has **30 ayaat**.

🔥 Other Names of Surah Al-Mulk

Surah Al-Mulk also has other beautiful names:

- **Al-Munjiya** (The One that Saves)
- **Al-Waqiyah** or **Al-Mani'ah** (The One that Protects)

Why? 😞

Because this surah protects the person who reads it from the punishment of Allah and from the punishment of the grave.

💖 What Is This Surah About?

Surah Al-Mulk talks about three big and important ideas:

1️⃣ About Allah and His Amazing Creation 🌍☀️

This surah teaches us about:

- Allah as our Creator
- The beautiful sky and the shining stars ☀️
- The earth and all the blessings on it
- Birds flying in the sky 🐦
- Flowing water 💧
- Our ears 👂 and eyes 👁️ that help us learn

It reminds us that Allah made everything perfectly!

2️⃣ About the Hereafter (Aakhirah) 🔥🌈

The surah also talks about:

- What happens after we die
- Hellfire and its punishment
- Conversations between the angels of punishment and the people in Hell

It teaches us to make good choices so we can go to Jannah.

3 A Warning for People Who Do Wrong ⚠️

This surah warns:

- People who do not believe
- People who are unfair and hurt others

It tells them that there are consequences in this life and in the next life.

🌙 The Special Reward of Reading Surah Al-Mulk

The Prophet's family taught us how special this surah is.

In a hadith from Imam Baqir (عليه السلام):

- Surah Al-Mulk protects from the punishment of the grave.
 - If someone reads it at night, they have done something very good.
 - They are not counted as someone who forgets Allah.
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🌱 Very Important Reminder

Just reading with our tongue is not enough.

We should:

- Think about the meaning 🗨️
- Try to understand it 📖
- Act upon it in our daily life ✨

When we read, think, and act — that is when the surah truly protects us.

☀ Surah Al-Mulk – Ayaat 1–10 ☀

(Simple Tafseer & Key Words for Grade 2–3)

Ayah 1

🌸 بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Meaning: In the Name of Allah, the Most Kind, the Most Merciful.

We start with Allah's name because He is loving and merciful to us 🤍

Ayah 1

تَبَارَكَ الَّذِي بِيَدِهِ الْمَلِكُ وَ هُوَ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

☀ Simple Meaning:

Allah is full of blessings.
All power belongs to Him.
He can do everything!

Key Words:

- تَبَارَكَ (Tabarak) → Full of blessings, always great
- الْمَلِكُ (Al-Mulk) → The Kingdom (everything in the world belongs to Allah)
- قَدِيرٌ (Qadeer) → All-Powerful

What We Learn:

Allah owns the whole universe 🌍☀
He is the King of everything — the sky, the earth, the animals, and us!

Ayah 2

الَّذِي خَلَقَ الْمَوْتَ وَ الْحَيَاةَ لِيَبْلُوَكُمْ أَيُّكُمْ أَحْسَنُ عَمَلًا

☀️ Simple Meaning:

Allah created life and death to test us.
He wants to see who does the best good deeds.

🔑 Key Words:

- خلق (Khalafa) → Created
- الموت (Al-Mawt) → Death
- الحياة (Al-Hayah) → Life
- ليبلوكم (Li-yabluwakum) → To test you
- احسن عملا (Ahsanu 'Amala) → Best actions

💡 What Is This Test?

This world is like a big classroom 🏠
Life is our test.

But Allah's test is not to make us fail.
It is to help us:

- Become better
- Be kind
- Be honest
- Learn about Allah

If we make mistakes, we should not feel hopeless.

Because Allah is:

و هو العزيز الغفور

He is Strong and He forgives 🧡

🌌 Ayah 3

الذى خلق سبع سماوات طباقا

☀️ Simple Meaning:

Allah created seven skies, one above the other.

And everything is perfect!

Key Words:

- سبع سماوات (Sab'a Samawat) → Seven heavens
- طباقا (Tibaqa) → Layered, one above another

Allah says:

ما ترى فى خلق الرحمن من تفاوت

You will not see any mistake in Allah's creation.

Everything works perfectly:

- The sun rises 
- The moon shines 
- The seasons change  

No mistakes. No cracks. No confusion!

Ayah 4

ثم ارجع البصر كرتين...

Simple Meaning:

Look again and again at the sky.

You will not find any mistake.

Your eyes will get tired — but you won't find anything wrong!

What We Learn:

The more we look at Allah's creation,
the more amazed we feel 

Ayah 5

و لقد زيننا السماء الدنيا بمصابيح

Simple Meaning:

Allah decorated the sky with shining stars 🌟

🔑 Key Words:

- السماء الدنيا (As-Sama' Ad-Dunya) → The nearest sky
- مصابيح (Masabeeh) → Lamps (stars)

The stars are beautiful lights in the sky.

Allah made them for beauty and for protection.

🔥 Ayah 6

و للذين كفروا بربهم عذاب جهنم و بنس المصير

🌟 Simple Meaning:

People who refuse to believe in Allah and ignore His signs will have punishment in Hell.

🔑 Key Words:

- كفروا (Kafaru) → Disbelieved
 - جهنم (Jahannam) → Hell
 - المصير (Al-Maseer) → Final place
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🌊 Ayah 7

إذا القوا فيها سمعوا لها شهيقا و هي تفور

🌟 Simple Meaning:

When they are thrown into Hell, they hear a scary sound.
It is boiling and roaring.

Like a pot boiling on fire — but much bigger.

😡 Ayah 8

تكاد تميز من الغيظ

☀️ Simple Meaning:

Hell is so angry it almost bursts apart.

The angels ask them:

“Didn’t someone warn you?”

🧠 Ayah 9

They answer:

“Yes, someone warned us.
But we did not believe.
We said Allah did not send anything.”

They did not listen.
They even said the messengers were wrong.

🧠 Ayah 10

و قالوا لو كنا نسمع او نعقل ما كنا فى اصحاب السعير

☀️ Simple Meaning:

They will say:

“If only we listened...
If only we used our brains...
We would not be in Hell.”

🔑 Key Words:

- نسمع (Nasma‘) → Listen
- نعقل (Na‘qil) → Think
- السعير (As-Sa‘eer) → Blazing Fire

Big Lessons for Us

- ✓ Listen carefully
- ✓ Think carefully
- ✓ Learn about Allah
- ✓ Do good deeds
- ✓ Be thankful

Allah gave us:

-  Ears to listen
-  Eyes to see
-  A brain to think
-  A heart to choose good

Let's use them the right way!

Ayah 11

فاعترفوا بذنبيهم فسحقا لاصحاب السعير

Simple Meaning:

In Hell, they will admit their mistake.
They will say, "Yes, we were wrong."

But it will be too late.

Key Word:

- ذنب (Dhanb) → Sin
- اعترفوا (I'tarafū) → They admitted

What We Learn:

Allah gave people:

-  Ears to listen

- 🧠 A brain to think
- 📖 Messengers to guide them

If we use them properly → we succeed!
If we ignore them → we lose.

🌸 Ayah 12

ان الذين يخشون ربهم بالغيب لهم مغفرة و اجر كبير

🌟 Simple Meaning:

People who fear Allah even when no one sees them will have forgiveness and a big reward.

🔑 Key Words:

- يخشون (Yakhshawna) → They fear (respect and love Allah)
- مغفرة (Maghfirah) → Forgiveness
- اجر كبير (Ajrun Kabeer) → Big reward

💛 What This Means:

If you:

- Tell the truth
- Pray
- Obey your parents
- Are kind

Even when no one is watching...

Allah sees you 👁️

And He rewards you 🌈

Ayah 13

و اسرؤا قولكم او اجهروا به انه علم بذآت الصدور

Simple Meaning:

You can speak quietly or loudly.
Allah knows what is inside your heart.

Key Word:

- علم (Aleem) → All-Knowing

Even if you whisper...
Even if you think something silently...

Allah knows 

Ayah 14

ا لا يعلم من خلق و هو اللطيف الخبير

Simple Meaning:

Wouldn't the One who created everything know everything?

Of course He knows!

Key Words:

- خلق (Khalaqa) → Created
- الخبير (Al-Khabeer) → Fully Aware

Allah made you.
He knows your thoughts, feelings, and secrets.

Ayah 15

هو الذى جعل لكم الارض ذلولا

Simple Meaning:

Allah made the earth easy and comfortable for you.

Key Word:

- ذلولا (Dhalool) → Easy, gentle, calm

The earth moves very fast in space 
But we don't feel it!

It is:

- Not too hot 
- Not too cold 
- Not too hard
- Not too soft

Perfect for living!

Allah says:

Walk on it.

Eat from its food.

But remember — you will return to Him.

Ayah 16

أ امنتم من فى السماء ان يخسف بكم الارض

Simple Meaning:

Do you feel completely safe?

If Allah wants,
He can make the earth shake 🌍

It can crack open
and swallow everything.

Ayah 17

ام امنتم من فى السماء ان يرسل عليكم حاصبا

☀️ Simple Meaning:

Or Allah can send a strong storm with stones.

Allah's power is everywhere.

He says:

You will see how serious My warnings are.

Ayah 18

و لقد كذب الذين من قبلهم فكيف كان نكير

☀️ Simple Meaning:

People before you also disbelieved.
And look what happened to them.

Some were punished with:

- Earthquakes
- Storms
- Lightning

Their ruined cities are lessons for us.

Ayah 19

ا و لم يروا الى الطير فوقهم صافات و يقبضن

Simple Meaning:

Don't they see the birds above them?

They spread their wings.

They fold their wings.

And they fly!

Who keeps them in the sky?

ما يمسكهن الا الرحمن

Only Allah holds them up.

Think About It:

Birds are heavy.

But they fly so smoothly!

Allah gave them:

- Special wings
- Light bodies
- Perfect design

Allah is taking care of them — and us!

Ayah 20

امن هذا الذى هو جند لكم ينصركم من دون الرحمن

Simple Meaning:

Who can protect you from Allah?

No army.
No helper.
No friend.

If Allah wants, no one can stop Him.

But many people are fooled.
They think they are strong —
but they forget Allah.

Ayah 21

امن هذا الذى يرزقكم ان امسك رزقه

Simple Meaning:

If Allah stops giving food and رزق (rizq),
who can give it to you?

Key Word:

- يرزقكم (Yarzuqukum) → Gives you food and blessings
- رزق (Rizq) → Food and everything we need

If:

- Rain stops 
- Plants don't grow 
- Crops get destroyed

Who can help us?

No one — only Allah.

But some people are stubborn.
They refuse to believe the truth.

Ayah 22

ا فمّن يمشى مكبا على وجهه اهدى امن يمشى سويا على صراط مستقيم

Simple Meaning:

Who is better?

Someone walking on their face...

Or someone walking straight on a clear path?

What This Means:

A disbeliever is like:

- Someone crawling on the ground
- Cannot see clearly
- Keeps falling

A believer is like:

- Someone standing tall
- Walking on a straight road
- Knows where they are going

Which one do you want to be? 😊

Ayah 23

قل هو الذى انشاكم و جعل لكم السمع و الابصار و الافئدة قليلا ما تشكرون

Simple Meaning:

Allah created you.

He gave you:

- 🦻 Ears to hear
- 👁️ Eyes to see
- ❤️ A heart to think

But many people do not thank Him.

🔑 Key Word:

- تشكرون (Tashkuroon) → You thank

How do we thank Allah?

By using our:

- Eyes to look at good things
- Ears to listen to Qur'an
- Heart to think about truth

🌍 Ayah 24

قل هو الذى ذرأكم فى الارض و اليه تحشرون

☀️ Simple Meaning:

Allah spread you across the earth.
And one day, everyone will return to Him.

This world is not forever.
We are traveling back to Allah.

🕒 Ayah 25

و يقولون متى هذا الوعد ان كنتم صادقين

☀️ **Simple Meaning:**

Some people laugh and say:

“When is the Day of Judgment?”

They are making fun.

🙏 **Ayah 26**

قل انما العلم عند الله و انما انا نذير مبين

☀️ **Simple Meaning:**

The Prophet says:

Only Allah knows when it will happen.

I am only here to warn you.

Allah keeps the time secret.

Why?

So we are always ready.

😞 **Ayah 27**

فلما راوه زلفة سينت وجوه الذين كفروا

☀️ **Simple Meaning:**

When they finally see the Day of Judgment coming close...

Their faces become dark and sad.

They are told:

“This is what you were asking about!”

Simple Meaning:

The Prophet tells them:

Even if I die...

Even if my followers die...

Who will save YOU from punishment?

No one can protect someone from Allah except Allah.

Ayah 29

قل هو الرحمن آمنا به و عليه توكلنا

Simple Meaning:

Say:

He is the Most Merciful.

We believe in Him.

We trust Him.

Key Word:

- **توكلنا (Tawakkalna)** → We trust Allah

Believers feel calm.

Because they rely on Allah.

Soon everyone will know who was truly right.

Ayah 30

قل ارايتم ان اصبح ماؤكم غورا فمن ياتيكم بماء معين

☀️ Simple Meaning:

If your water disappears deep into the ground...

Who can bring you fresh, flowing water?

🔑 Key Words:

- ماء (Maa') → Water
- معين (Ma'een) → Flowing water

Water gives life to:

- People
- Animals
- Plants

If Allah takes it away —
no one can bring it back.
